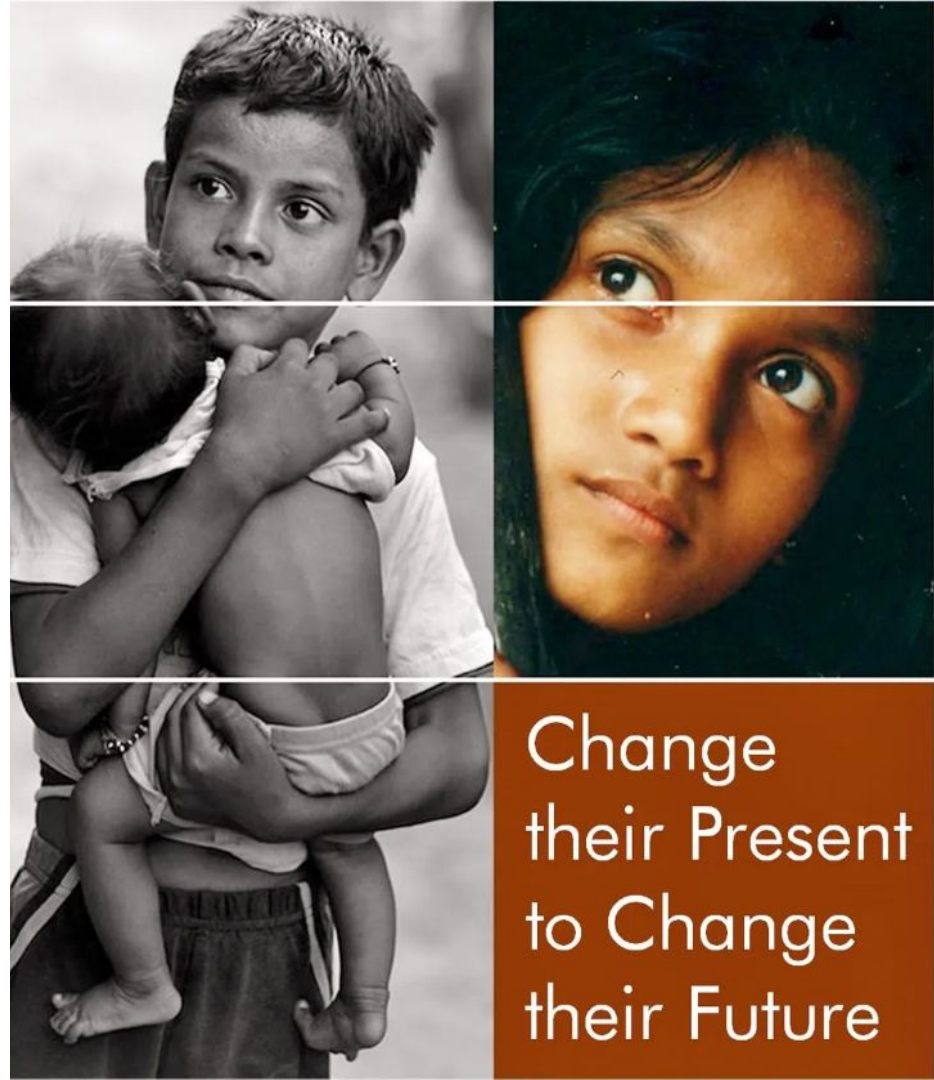

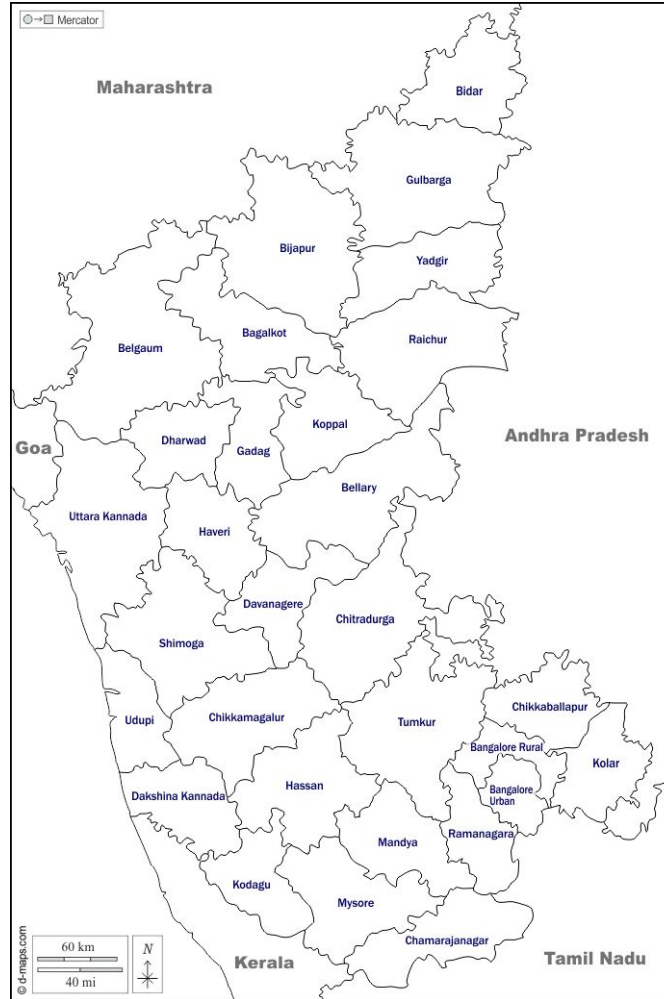

# Activities

## Saksham:

**June-Aug 2025:** Post the start of new academic session in June- 2025 we covered 570+ students providing them with School kits ( Note books, Geometry box, Pen, Pencil and other materials) and other study material in the 4 districts.

**July - Aug 2025:** We also felicitated and awarded 60 students who scored above 75% above in 10th std, PUC and Degree.

### **Awarded based on scores:**

Students who scored >75%: Received Rs. 2000/-.

Students who scored >80%: Received Rs. 4000/-.

Students who scored >90%: Received Rs. 5000/-.

**July - Aug 2025:** Supported school fees for 260+ students who were studying in 1st std to 10th std. AIFT student's fees amount was paid after receiving the receipt from the school for the fees.

In 260 students 61% students scored A+ & A grade, 34% students scored B+ & B grade and 5% of students scored C+ grade in previous academic year.



**Aug-2025:** We had the privilege of celebrating Independence Day with the children of Veerasagagara Government School. As part of the celebration, we distributed uniforms, notebooks, and pens to support their educational journey.

**Sep-Oct 2025:** Supported college fees for 170+ students who are studying in PUC, Degree and Master Degree. In all 5 districts student's college fees was sent to accounts through NEFT. The students studying in P.U.C, Diploma and Graduation. PUC/ Diploma students with score <60% Received Rs: 2000/- and those with scores > 60% received Up to Rs: 5000/- as scholarship support. Degree students with score <60% Received Rs: 4000/- and those with scores > 60% received Up to Rs: 12000/-and medical student scholarship support is Rs: 25000/- as College fees support.

**November -2025:** Endowment programme conducted by AIFT and supported by C V kamath for his mother's birthday. In this programme 24 students were benefited.

**June 2025-Feb-2026:** We have successfully collected over 700+ books through the generous support of donors and a portion of these books was distributed to students and beneficiaries, supporting their educational journey and the remaining collection was used to set up a small community library at our office, providing free access to books for children, donors and local residents.



**February-2026: Suprajit foundation** supported scholarship for 122 students out of the AIFT list in these five districts studying in P.U.C and Degree.

Suprajit Foundation had selected 109 students across five districts studying in PUC, Diploma and Degree. PUC/ Diploma students with score <60% Received Rs: 3000/- and those with scores > 60% received Up to Rs: 5000/- as scholarship support. Degree students with score <60% Received Rs: 5000/- and those with scores > 60% received Up to Rs: 15000/- as scholarship support.

**Trust line endowment May-25 till to date:**

1. Coaching Support for NEET and JEEE for 7 Students in Tirunelveli, Tamil Nadu. The amount was directly paid to the tutorial center every month from May- 2025.
2. Other 15 student's fees amount was directly paid to the colleges and Schools.
3. Tuition support for 10th class 5 students in Tirunelveli, Tamil Nadu.



## Sampoorna-Swasthya:

A Women's Health Workshop was successfully conducted in October 2025, featuring **Dr. Vidyashri Kamath C**, a renowned Obstetrician and Gynaecologist from KMC Hospital, Mangalore, as the main speaker. The session focused on raising awareness about key aspects of women's health and well-being, with active participation from approximately 60 members.

February 2026, a health camp was conducted in Chamarajanagara district, with the participation of 35 women beneficiaries. The initiative focused on promoting awareness and supporting women's health at the community level.

## Samartha:

**July - Aug 2025:** Provided direct financial support to four specially abled sportspersons to assist with their training needs.

**Dec-2025:** We have selected a government school in Puttur, Dakshina Kannada district, to provide proper toilets.

# We Plan to initiate the following activities in next Twelve months:

## Saksham

**Continuing the education support:** Provide tuition support for children who require personal care. Special counselling sessions will also be arranged with AIFT mentors. Based on the status of the children mind, personal counselling will be provided.

**NEET/CET other coaching support:** Students studying in 2nd PUC with high score in 1<sup>st</sup> PUC and are found competent to join Medical/Engineering or any other professional courses will be supported for coaching classes.

We will select **6** Interior rural Govt schools to provide Proper toilets, One lab set up, One smart class and Sports materials in 5 new districts.



## **Sampoorna Swasthya:**

We will cover 200+ students for their health diagnostic working with local hospital support. We will also enable families who are not enrolled in Govt health schemes like BPL-Ayushman Bharat and provide need based financial support to economically disadvantaged families in case of serious illness. We will also cover awareness sessions on out to keep good health for women and girls in the current environment.

## **Samarth:**

We will provide 30+ students for skill development and professional training to our beneficiaries who are studying in degree colleges working with local training centre and in our rural centre.

We will support self-business like providing Tailoring machine, Small shop business support and Home based small business for 10 women.
